Hoping we can all get together soon.

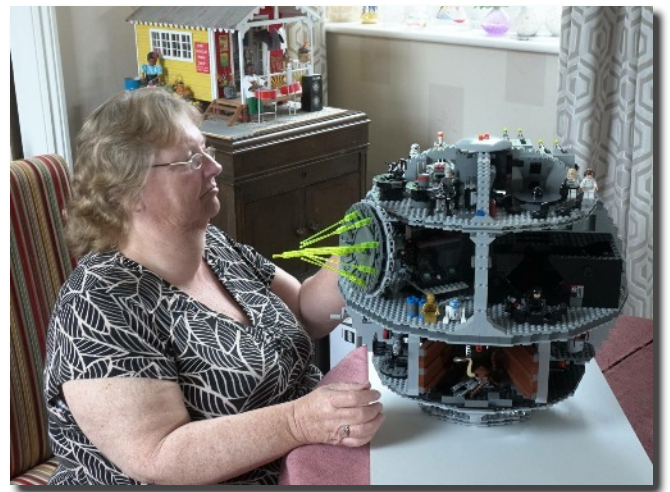
