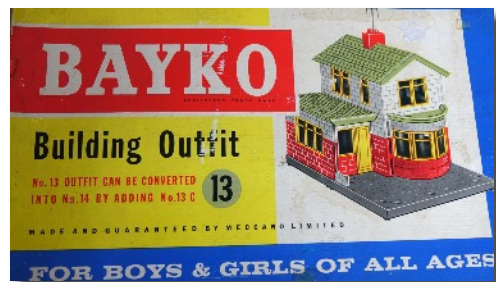
## Club Matters

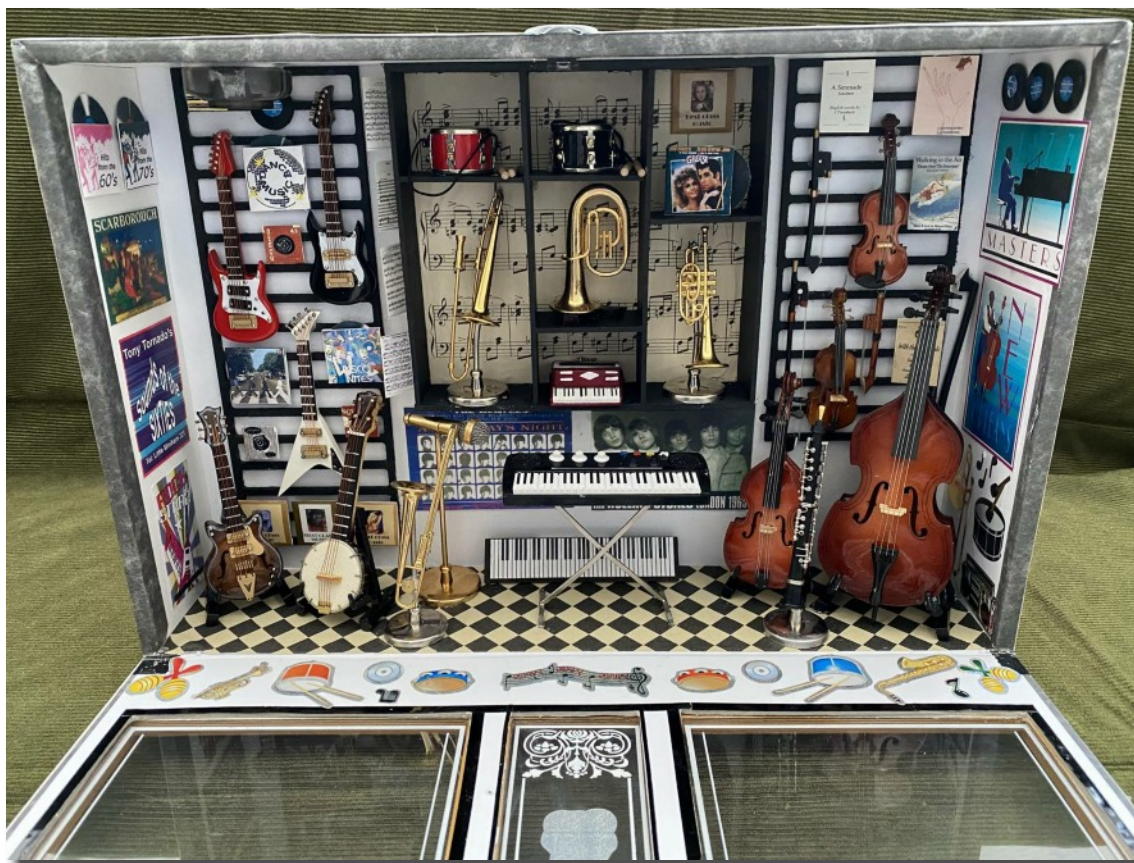
