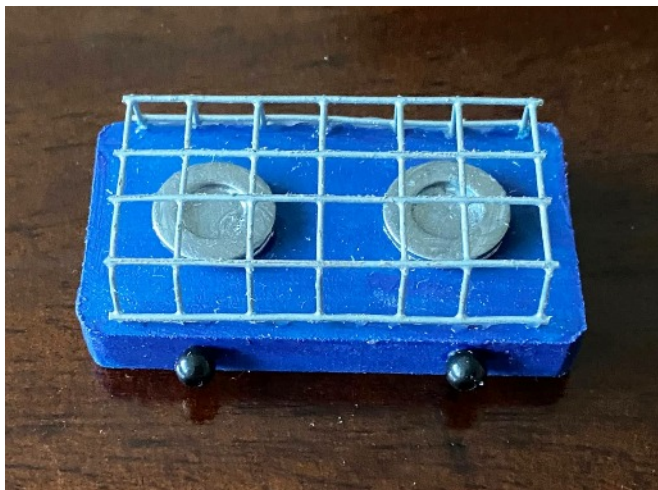
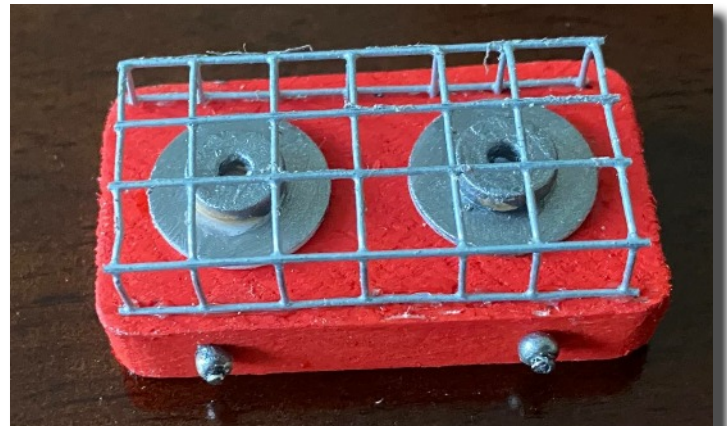
Helen's Florida Mansion
