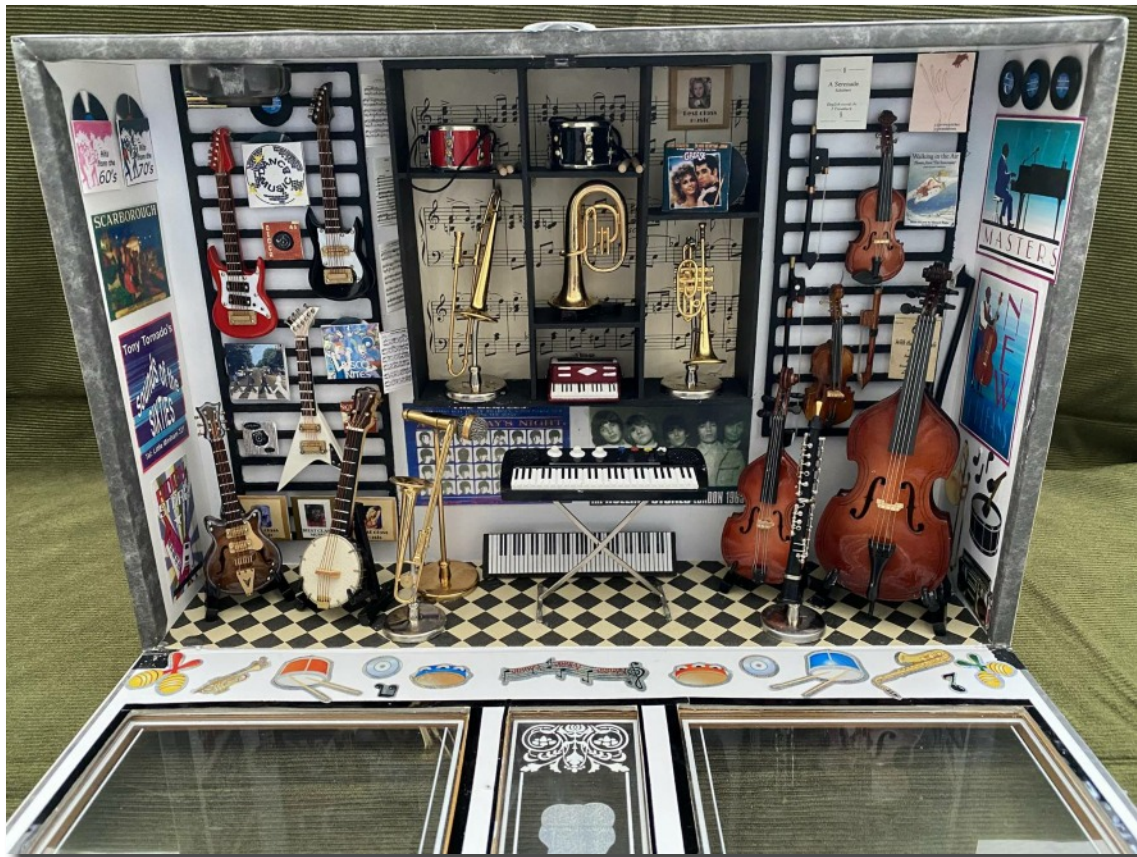




The Box File Project for 2021.
