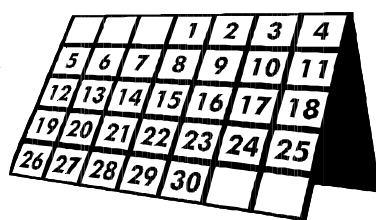

**Apologies** were received from **Beryl Sweet, Ann Griffin, Beverley Marshall, Jill Shorthose** - all on holiday.

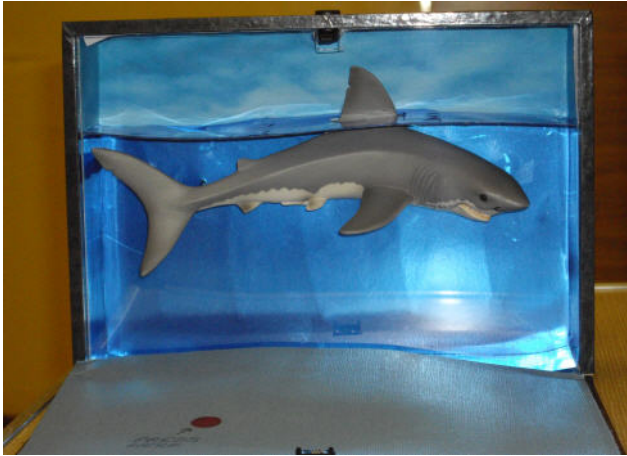
Also - continued get well wishes to **Marrilynne Snowden** and our sincere condolences to **Doreen Smith**, whose sister passed away that day.
